

## Tournament Rules:

- All throwers keep their start number throughout the tournament. It must be worn so that it is clearly visible for scoring. Ideally on the back or on the right rear side.
- The axe must comply with the regulations.
- One test throw per new disc.
- Points are scored by the referee in accordance with the rules. The surface of the disc is decisive.
- The handwritten entries of the hit recording are decisive for the result. It is recorded independently in duplicate. Objections to the tournament organisers. The comparison of the original with the copy will then count.
- Questions will not be answered at the scoring car. Please contact the tournament organisers.
- In the event of a tie, there will be a play-off for the places among the first 12 or for advancement to the next round.  
Play-off: 1 trial throw (with new disc), 1 throw until a decision is made.
- In each new round, the points start at 0 (zero).
- The event starts as scheduled on each of the 3 days at around 10.00 a.m. with the briefing for the day.
  
- **Please keep the throw-in discs free for throwers who will be on in the foreseeable future.**
  
- Depending on weather conditions or other. imponderables, the modes may change!!!
- The qualifying order corresponds to the starting numbers.
- Teams must be registered with the tournament organisers using the forms no later than the end of the preliminary round.
- A team can consist of women and men.
- If a team is still missing throwers, they will be filled with 'free' throwers by the tournament organisers. Free throwers must report to the tournament organisers by the end of the preliminary round.

## Tournament schedule: Friday

### Men single preliminary round

36 throws (2 rounds: 12 throws each on 2 targets)  
30 throwers in next round

### Women single preliminary round

36 throws (2 rounds: 12 throws each on 2 targets)  
10 female throwers in next round

### Youth single preliminary round

36 throws (2 rounds: 12 throws each on 2 targets)  
everyone gets ahead

## Tournament schedule: Saturday

### Lucky loser round

Best 6 women and 10 men advance (12 throws on 2 discs)

### Team preliminary round

There are 12 throws per person on one target per team of 3.  
12 teams in the next round

### Intermediate round men

Best 40 throwers (12 throws on 2 discs); the last 20 are eliminated

### Intermediate round women

Best 16 throwers (12 throws on 2 discs); the last 4 are eliminated

### Intermediate round men

Best 20 throwers (12 throws on 2 discs); the last 8 are eliminated

### Semi-final team

Best 12 teams (12 throws each on 2 discs); the last 6 are eliminated

## Tournament schedule: Sunday

### Final Team

Best 6 teams (3 throws on 1 target per team member). Last team out in succession!

### Semi and final women

Best 12 throwers (12 throws on 2 discs); the last 6 are eliminated  
Best 6 throwers (3 throws on 1 disc). Last out one after the other!

### Youth final

Beste Werfer (3 Wurf auf 1 Scheibe). Nacheinander letzter Raus!

### Semi and final men

Best 12 throwers (12 throws on 2 discs); the last 6 are eliminated  
Best 6 throwers (3 throws on 1 disc). Last out one after the other!
